The Discovery

The English archaeologist,
Howard Carter, discovered
the tomb of Tutankhamun in
1922 after 5 long years of
searching. The resting
place of the young king, was
the only tomb of a New
Kingdom Pharaoh to escape
almost untouched by
robbers. Tutankhamun is
remembered for his tomb in
the valley of the Kings, and is
the most famous Pharaoh of

The king was buried with his 2 daughters and over 5,000 fantastic treasures including his golden throne. The King's tomb was full of weapons, clothes, furniture, musical instruments and model boats. The mask was made of solid gold and a blue stone called lapis lazuli.
